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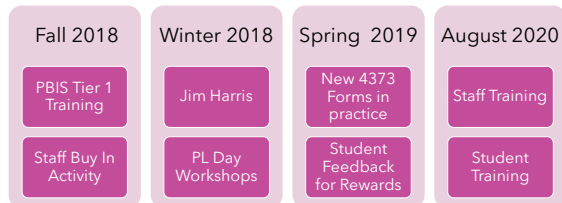

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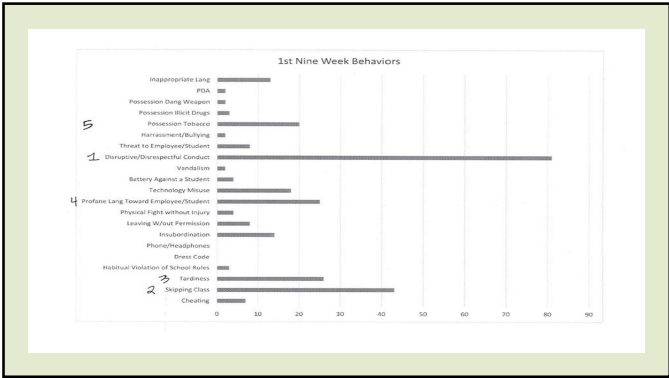
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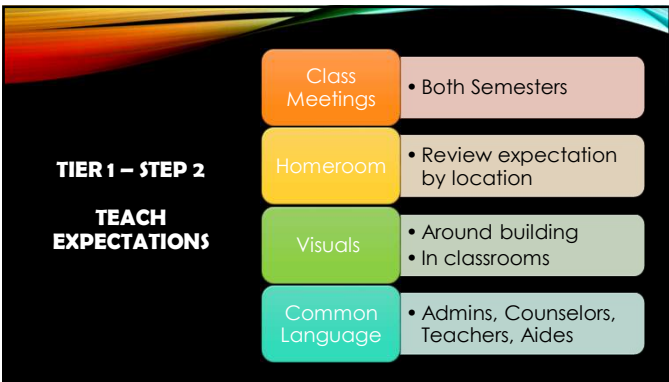

Individualized interventions for students with intensive/chronic behavior challenges
- Targeted (Tier II)**  
Specialized interventions for learners who are at risk for academic or social failure due to behavior challenges
- Universal (Tier I)**  
School-wide interventions for all learners

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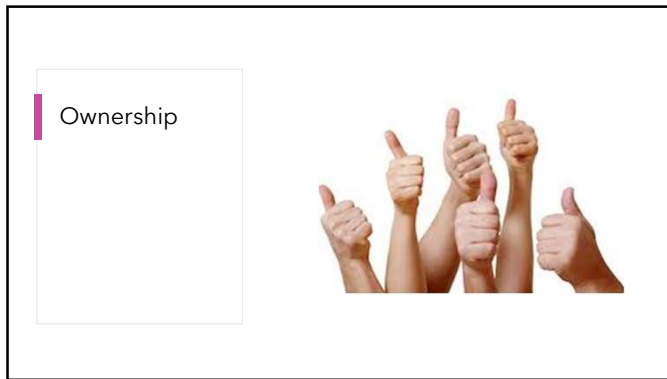

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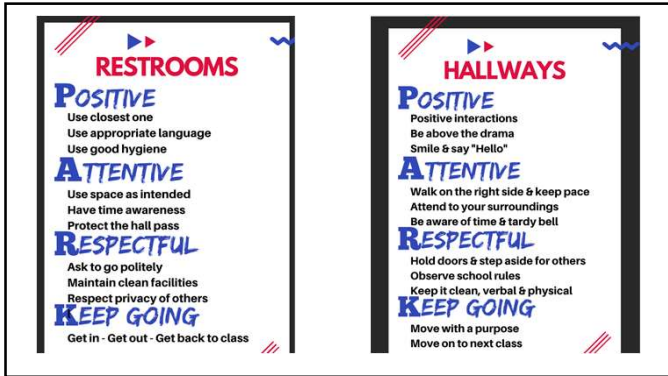
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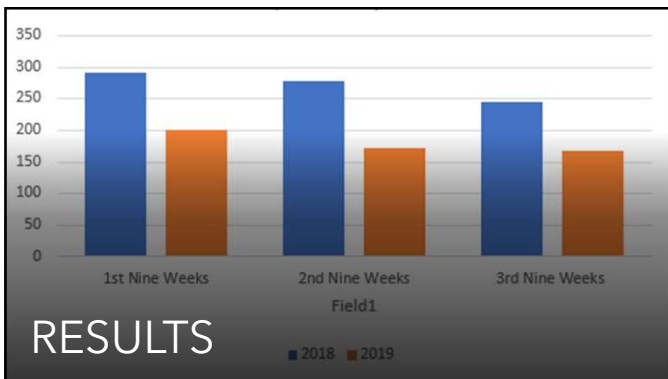
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### Results
