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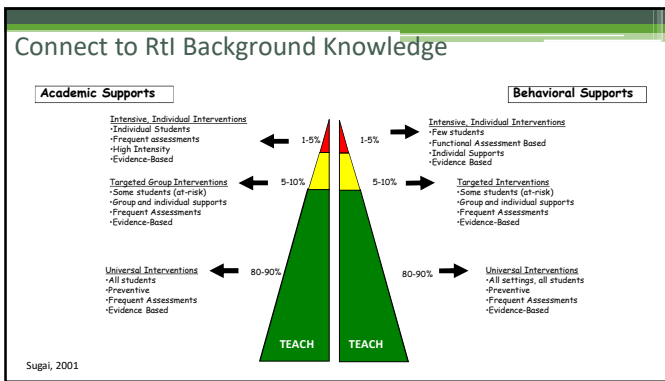
How can we afford not to intervene?

- Countywide

 - 2015 McNinch Elem and Central Elem (2 feeder schools)
 - 2016 Sherrard Middle School and feeder schools
 - 2017 Remaining Schools
 - 2018 Self Assessment and refresher for the entire county
- Administrative Support at School and County Level



Tier I – Building a Solid Foundation

- School-wide self assessment
 - Tiered Fidelity Inventory
 - School Culture Survey
- Teaching school behavior and expectations
 - PBIS weekly lessons for the school
 - Second Steps / LINKS
 - Parent and Community
- Predictability
 - Routines
 - Monitoring common space

Personal Area of Focus


- Universal Screening at Tier I per student
- Focus – Student Assistance Team training and Implementation
 - Form revision with goals, assignments and interventions specified

Instructional/Support Intervention Plan

(Not address EACH area of concern on initial referral form; provide copy to all relevant team members)


Goal (based on area of concern) – What Outcome Will Be Met?	Intervention(s); How will specific weakness be targeted. What interventions will be implemented?	Person (s) Responsible	Data Collection Method; frequency of data collection; measurement instrument used.	Projected Date of Review

Tier II – Progress Monitoring



- Monitoring Data to Target Struggling Students
 - Tiered Fidelity Inventory
 - SAT log review
 - Discipline data review / PBIS team meetings
- Re-Teaching school behavior and expectations
 - Mentor Program/Check in check out
 - SAT intervention planning
 - Weekly reteach lessons
 - Social Skills Groups – Teachtown Social and Second Steps reteach

Tier III – Individual Interventions



- Monitoring Data to Target Struggling Students
 - Functional Behavior Assessment
 - Behavior Intervention Plans
 - Crisis Plans
- Integrity of intervention implementation
 - Risk/Threat Assessments
 - Community Services
 - Individual Therapy Services
