

PBIS Coaches Roles and Responsibilities

Four Main Roles (Spouse, 2001)

- Supervision
- Teaching while engaging in practice activities
- Assessment and feedback
- Provision of emotional support

Responsibilities

- Attend all team meetings
- Ensure teams are fully implementing all PBIS components with fidelity
- Help team analyze discipline data
- Support teams in addressing challenges and/or barriers to the process
- Support teams to stay on track and remain positive
- Support staff in sharing responsibilities for teaching, acknowledging, and promoting PBIS efforts
- Complete Baseline and End-of-Year Evaluations
- Coaches should help teams identify the following:
 - Who will coordinate the meeting logistics? (e.g., time, location, notification, etc.)
 - Who will set the agendas?
 - Who will facilitate the team meetings?
 - Who will be the Recorder? Time keeper? Snack Master?
 - Who will collect the discipline data?
 - Who will analyze and summarize graphs before the meeting?
